- India's Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL) has opened its first overseas office in Dhaka. This office will serve as a liaison office for the company.
- Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL) was incorporated as a company on 22 April 1993. It was established in accordance with the provisions made in the historic Assam Accord signed on 15 August 1985.
- India's first refinery was established in 1901 at Digboi, Assam. By 1947, it was the only refinery with a capacity of 0.50 million metric tons per annum (MMTPA).
- Present HPCL's Mumbai Refinery was the first modern refinery to be set up after independence by Esso in 1954.

- Bharatiya Janata Party had requested renaming of Ahmednagar district in Maharashtra after renaming Aurangabad to Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar and Osmanabad to Dharashiv.
